General Information: The show will run from high to low, starting with preliminary or training level in the morning and finishing with grasshopper. It is likely we will start at 8 a.m. Riders perform their dressage test then show jump in the designated show jumping time window for their division. There will be time to change tack. Dressage tests are to be ridden from memory – no callers allowed. Fly masks and nose nets are permitted. Prizes to first place and ribbons from first through fifth place for all divisions. Lynnleigh Farm reserves the right to refuse entries. NEW: Horses may only be judged in one division with one rider. However, a horse may be ridden a second time in the same division or in the next lower division by a different rider. The second pair will not be judged for placing, but they will get a dressage test score and a stadium score for reference only. Each pair must pay a separate entry fee.

There may not be room for non 2-phase only rides this show – complete 2 phase entries will be scheduled first. Please do send in your entry – in you don't get in, you will receive a full refund including PayPal fees. No show jumping rounds are available for non-competitors.
